

A photocopy of the inspection report dated 18.08.2017 is enclosed herewith for necessary compliance. The compliance report (alongwith all supporting documents / proofs such as bills of materials / items procured, photographs / maps of facilities created, etc.) be submitted at the earliest.**

The above provisional affiliation for the existing UG/~~PG~~ courses with earlier sanctioned intake is further subject to the condition that the institute will make full compliance of the provisions laid down in the Statute, Ordinance and the decisions taken by this University from time to time.

Further, it is made clear that in the event of non compliance / fulfillment of the prescribed conditions / requirements, the University shall have the right to withdraw / refuse the provisional affiliation to the institute in the next academic session and all responsibilities arising due to such refusal / withdrawl would solely be that of the said institute / trust.

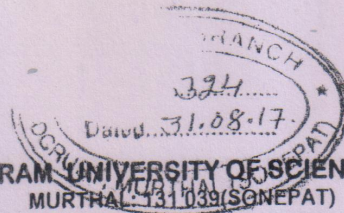


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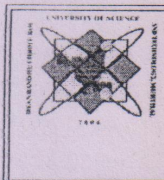

Category A	Provisional affiliation for a period of THREE years may be granted. Condition: Institute should obtain at least 75% marks separately in each Part II and Part III of the assessment report and the institute exists in a permanent campus of its own in a conforming area.
Category B	Provisional affiliation for a period of TWO years may be granted. Condition: Institute should obtain at least 65% - 74% marks separately in each Part II and Part III of the assessment report and the institute exists in a permanent campus of its own in a conforming area
Category C	Provisional affiliation for a period of ONE year may be granted. Condition: Institute should obtain at least 50% - 64% marks separately in each Part II and Part III of the assessment report and the institute exists in a permanent campus of its own in a conforming area.
Category D	The institute shall be kept under 'No Admission Category'. If assessment marks are less than 875 (Less than 50%)

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- If the admission in a particular course of B Tech/B Arch/ BBA/BCA is less than 10 % of the sanctioned strength for previous consecutive three years, the committee shall recommend for de-affiliation of that particular course or no admission category.
- If the admission in a particular course of M Tech/MBA/ M Arch/MCA is less than 20 % of the sanctioned strength for previous consecutive three years, the committee shall recommend for de-affiliation of that particular course or no admission category.
