Overview

Indian Higher Education (IHE) System is on the path of transformation through the implementation of National Education Policy-2020 by the Ministry of Education, Government of India. Functions of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

Some of the functions expected from the IQAC are:

- 1. Development and application of quality benchmarks/parameters for the various academic and administrative activities of the college.
- 2. Facilitating the creation of a learner-centric environment conducive to quality education and faculty maturation to adopt the required knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning process.
- 3. Arrangement for feedback responses from students, parents, and other stakeholders on quality-related institutional processes.
- 4. Dissemination of information on the various quality parameters of higher education.
- 5. Organization of inter and intra-institutional workshops, seminars on quality-related themes, and promotion of quality circles.
- 6. Documentation of the various programs/activities of the college, leading to quality improvement.
- 7. Acting as a nodal agency of the college for coordinating quality-related activities, including the adoption and dissemination of good practices.
- 8. Development and maintenance of institutional database through MIS for the purpose of maintaining/enhancing the institutional quality.
- 9. Development of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) of the college based on the quality parameters/assessment criteria developed by the relevant quality assurance body (like NAAC, NBA, NIRF) in the prescribed format.
- 10. Bi-annual development of Quality Radars (QRs) and ranking of integral units of college based on the AQAR.
- 11. Interaction with State Quality Assurance Cell (SQACs) in the pre and post-accreditation quality assessment, sustenance and enhancement endeavors.

- The faculty will motivate, encourage, and inspire students through their capacities such as class teacher, mentor, and guide.


3. Role of Students
