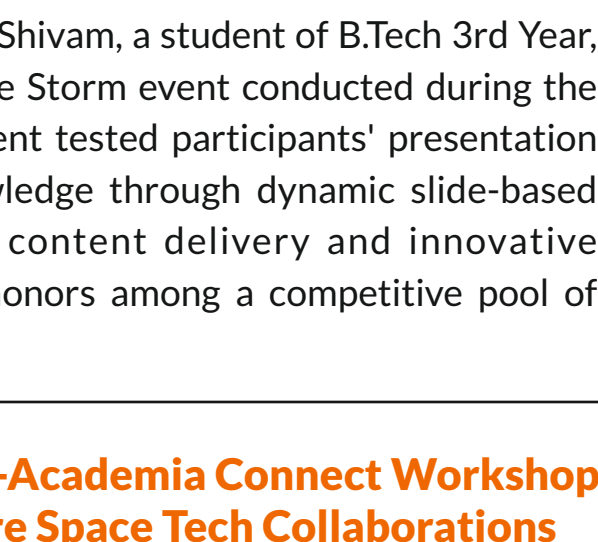
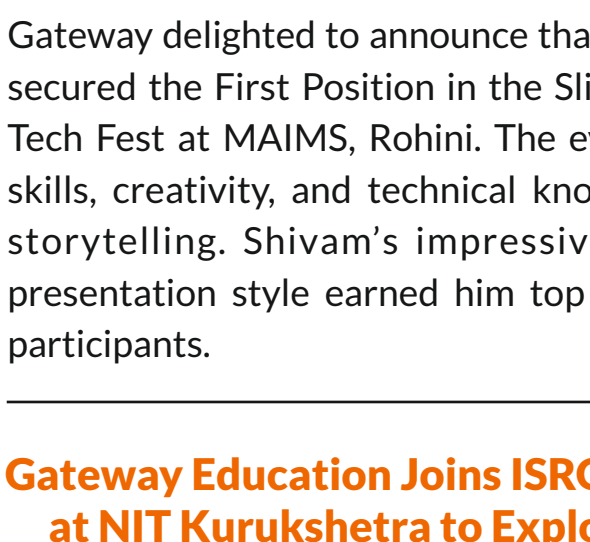

### Weaving Spaces: Hands-On Workshop on Net Weaving



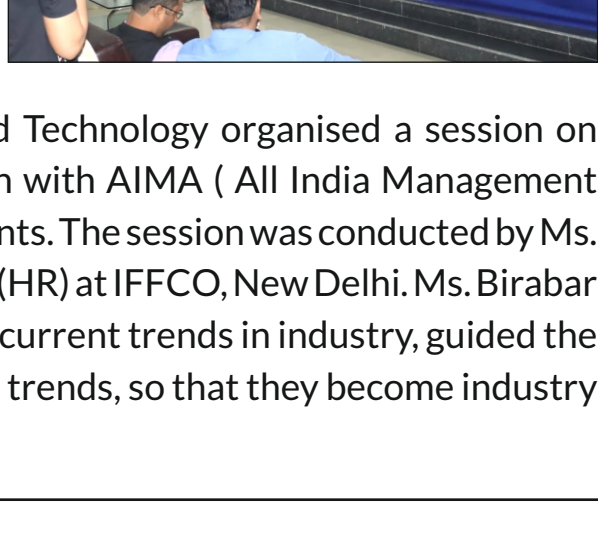
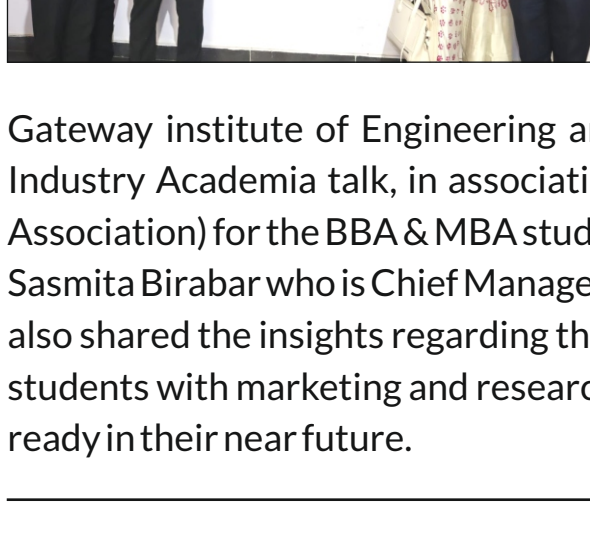

### GIET Hosted First Peer-to-Peer Learning Session on Cybersecurity, Led by COE President Aayush



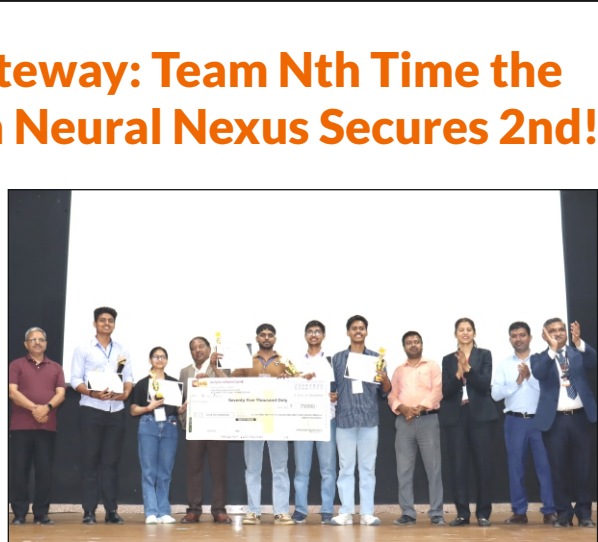

### Seminar on Emerging IT Careers Empowers Pre-Final Year Students at GIET



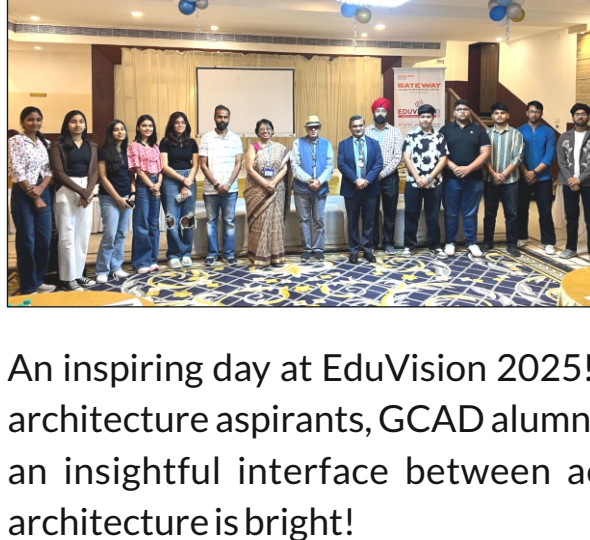

### Team Neural Nexus Shines at Vigyanoday 2025 Technical Fest



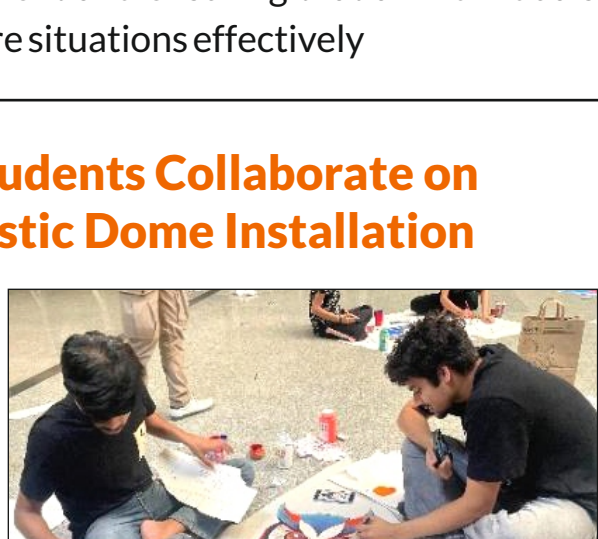
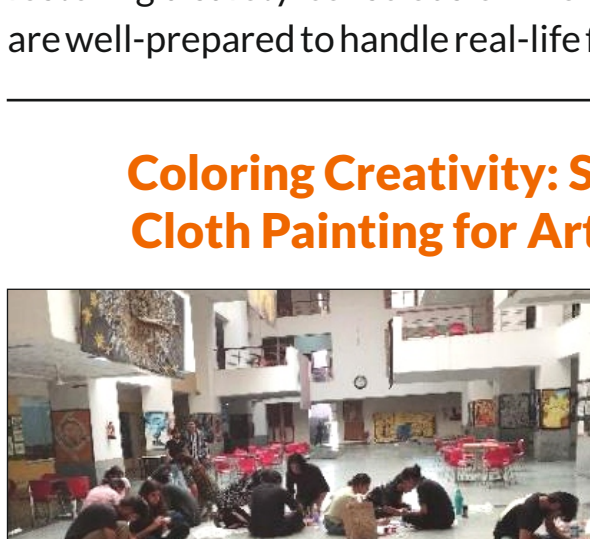

### GIET Students Gain IT Industry Insights During Industrial Visit to IBM India



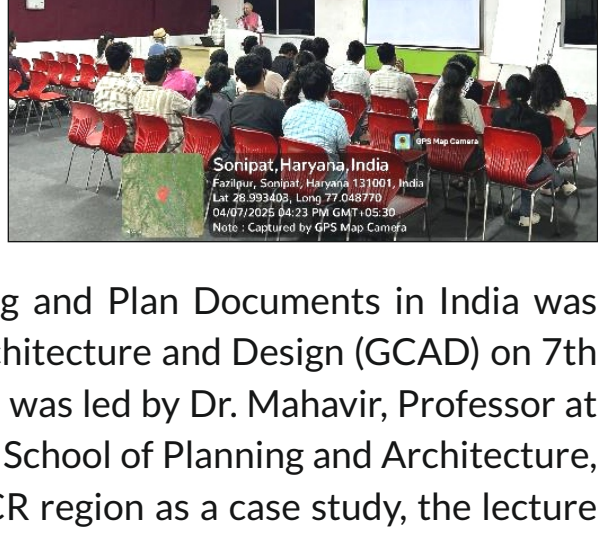

### Gateway Education Signs MoU with Spread Smile Foundation to Promote Academic Social Responsibility



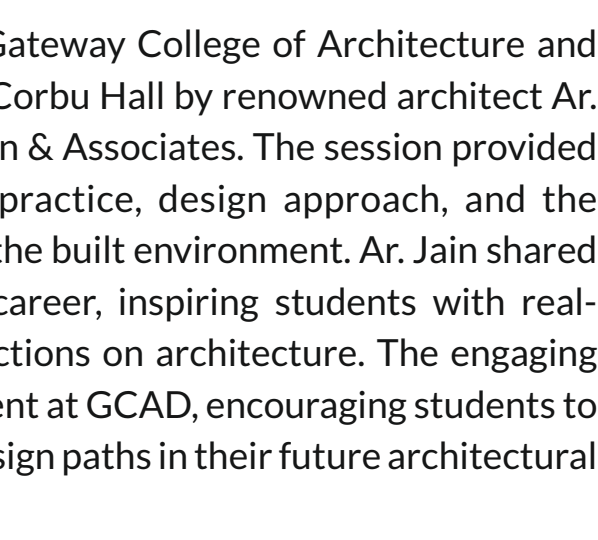
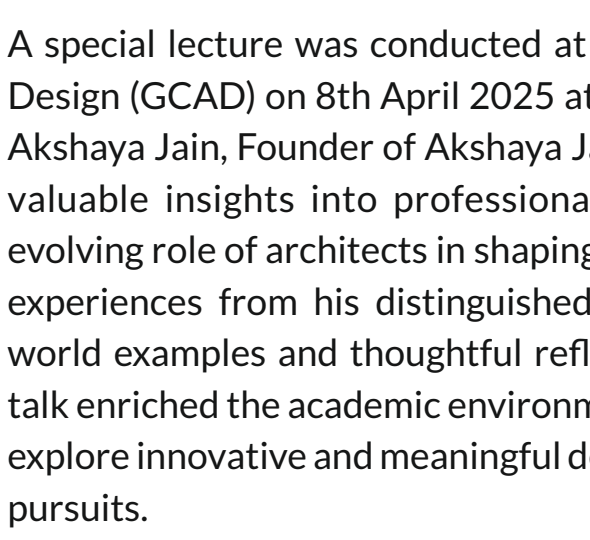
