### Celebrating Creativity: Remembering Piyush Pandey – The Icon of Indian Advertising



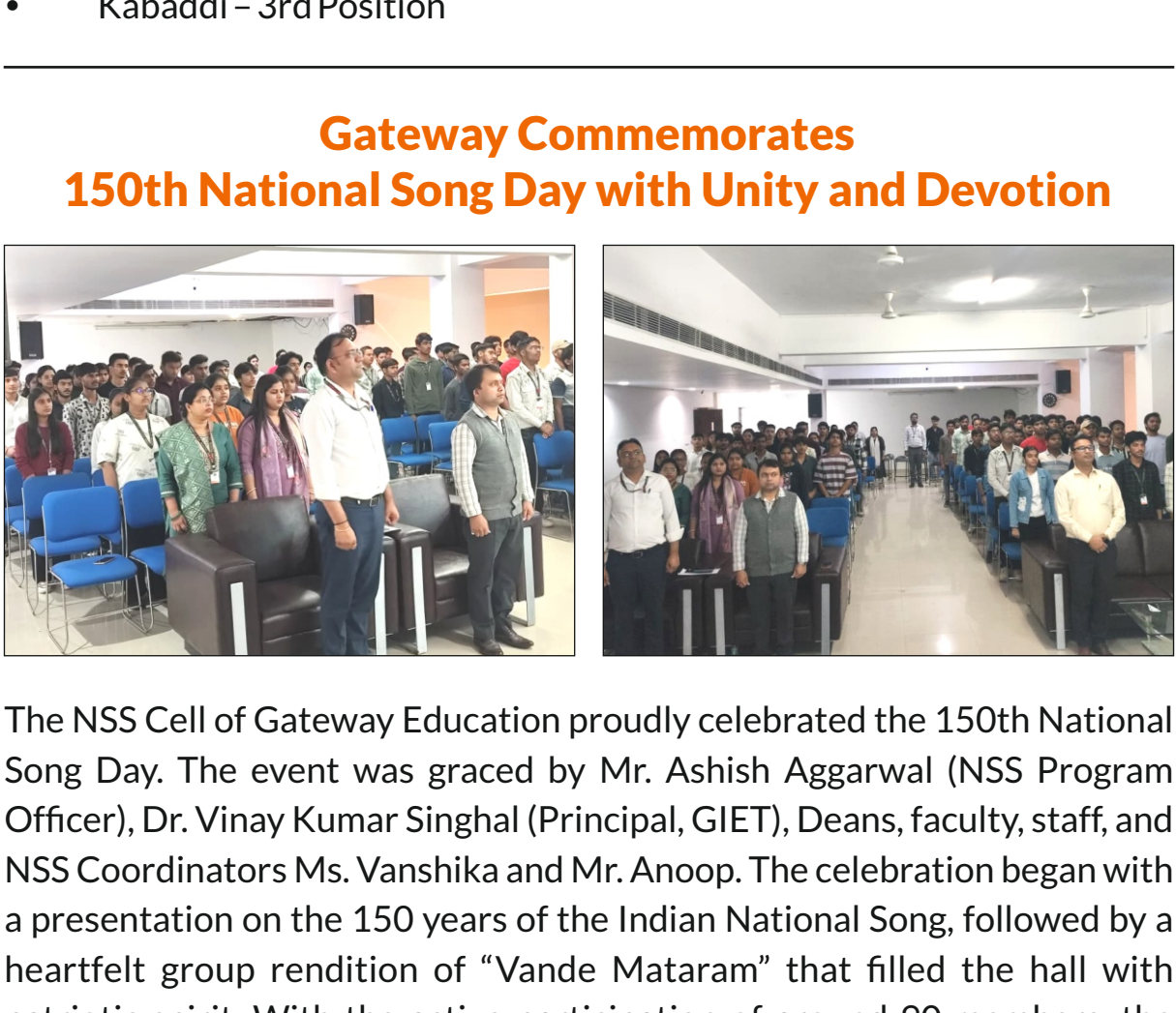

### Nav Jyoti School Students Visit Gateway Campus for Career Guidance and College Insights



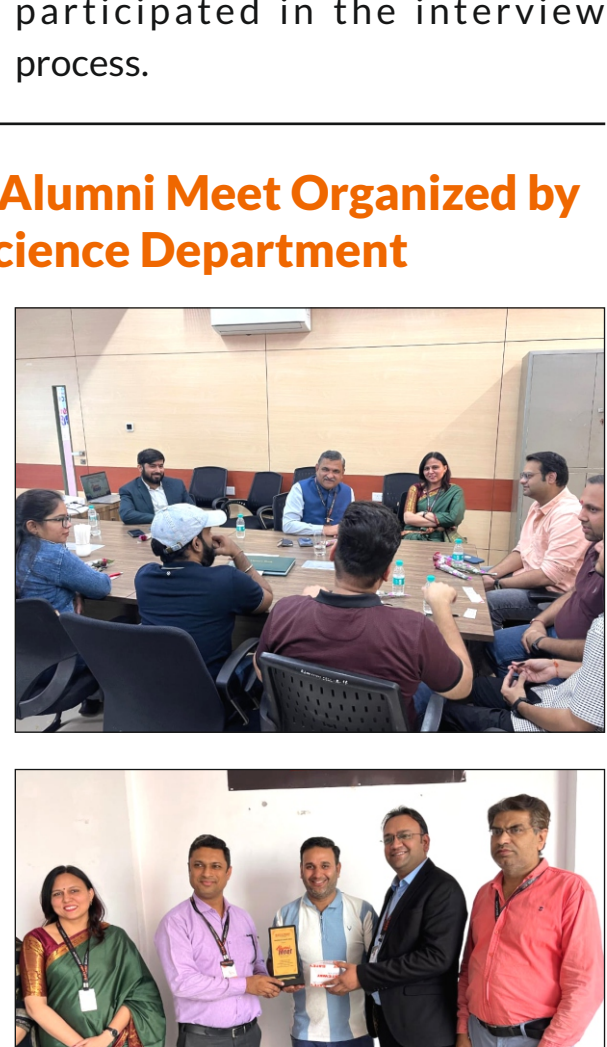

### PropUser Campus Placement Drive Engages 27 Gateway Students Across Streams



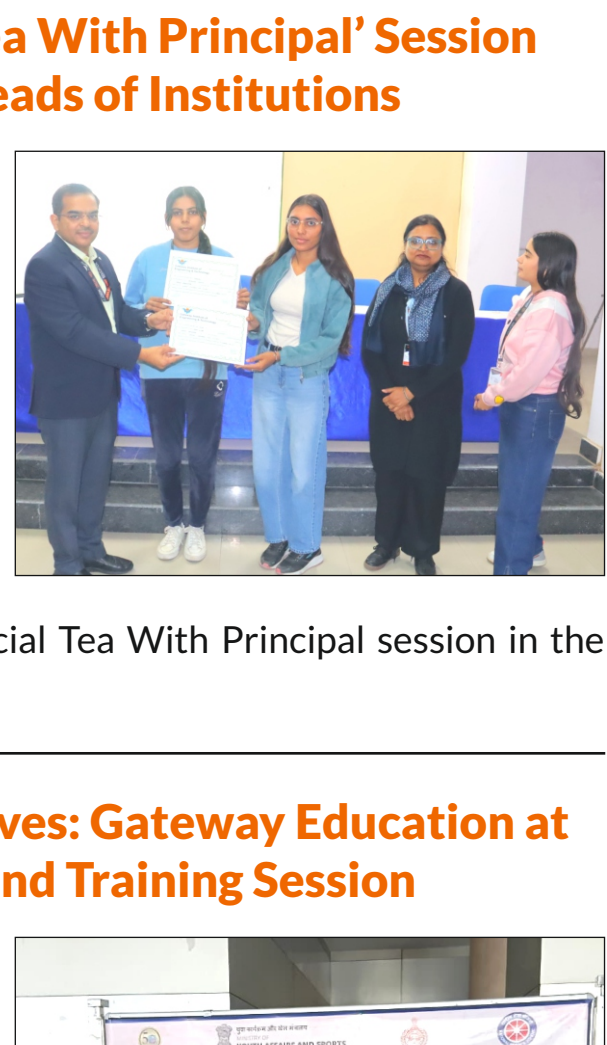
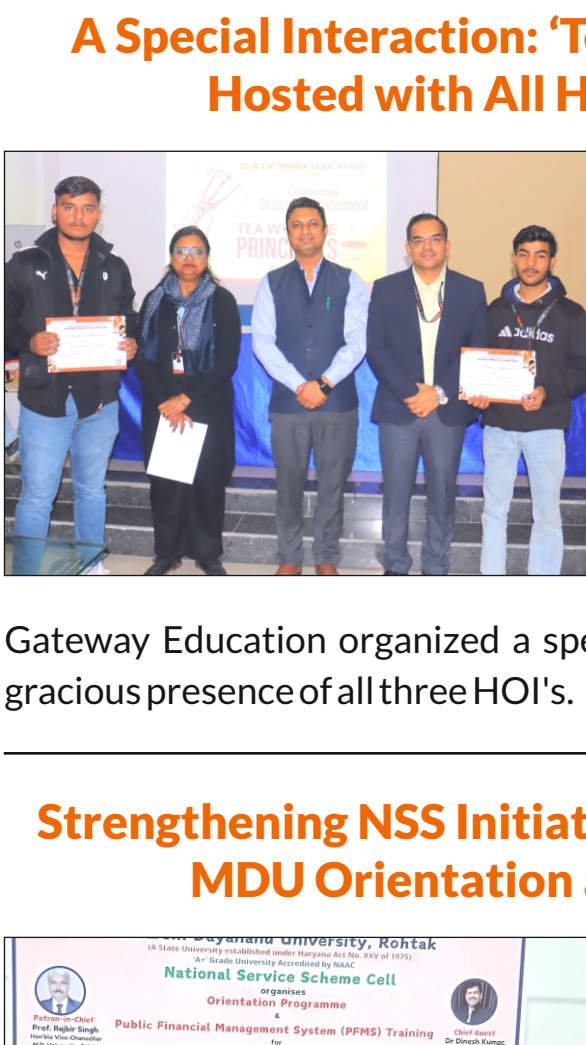

### Bridging Past and Present: Alumni Meet Organized by GIET's Computer Science Department



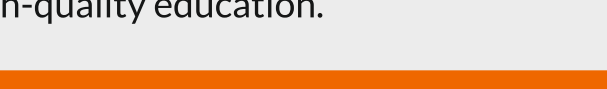
