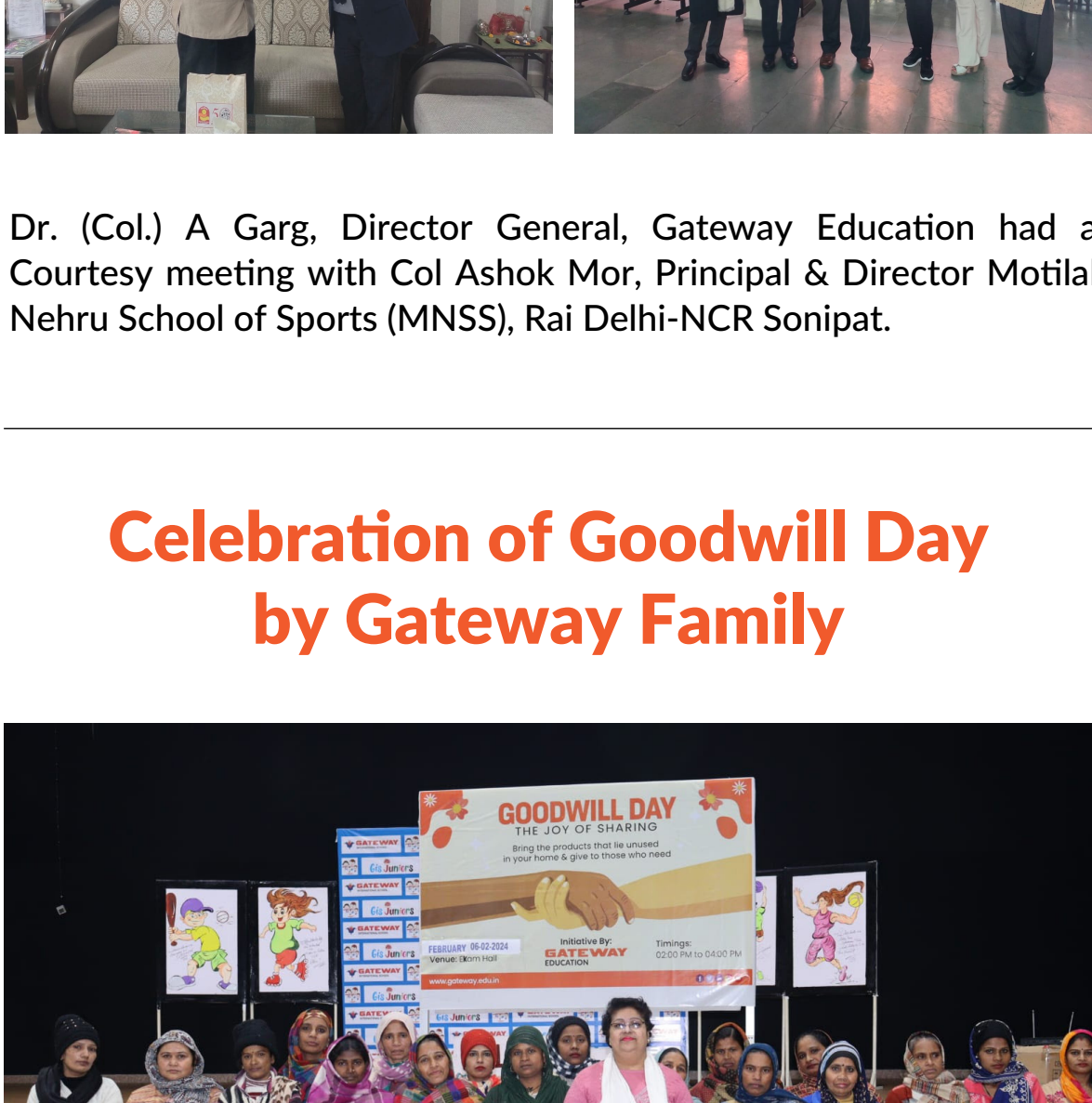

### Our Students Making Us Proud with Campus Placement



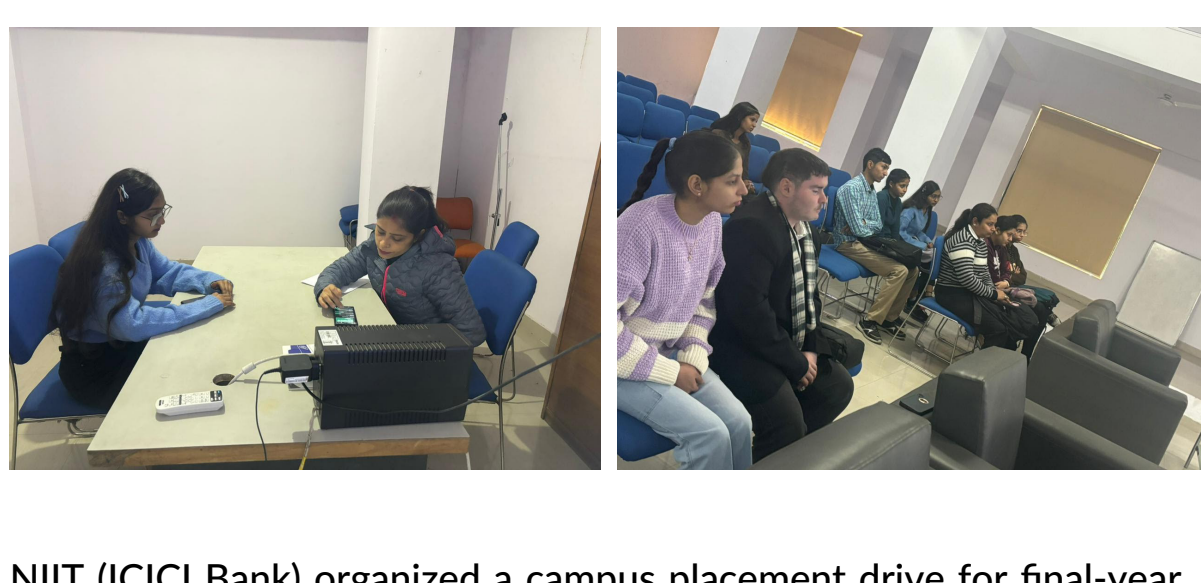

### Celebration of Goodwill Day by Gateway Family



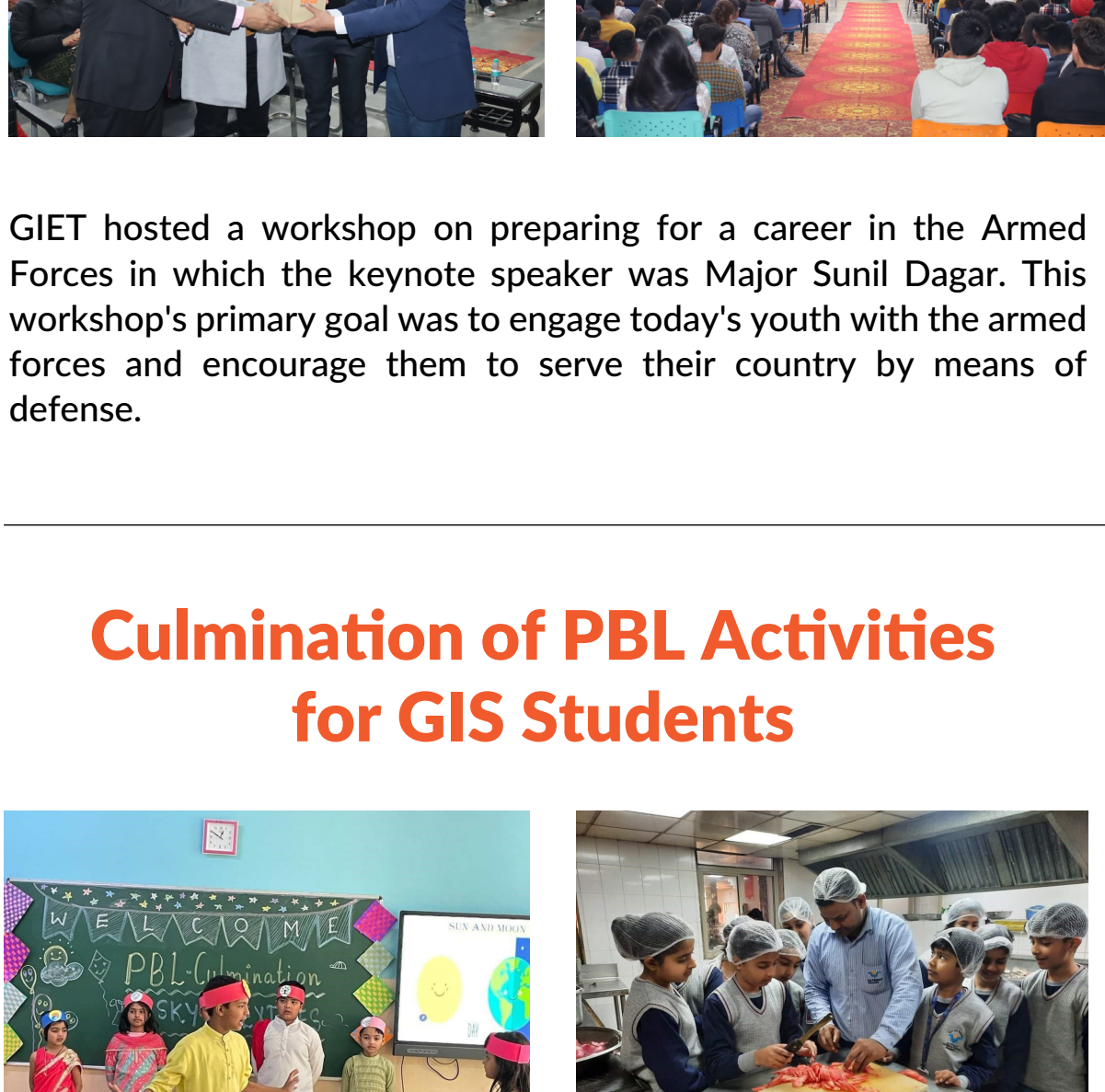
