A key suggestion that emerged was to organise a guided campus tour for new students covering major facilities such as the swimming pool, shooting range and other important areas. This initiative will help students become familiar with the full range of resources and opportunities available to them.</p> <p>It was also agreed that all student clubs operating under the Dean SW should conduct short orientation sessions to introduce their activities to the incoming batch. Decision taken on Agenda (g)	<p>(g) G-VAC courses being run for Odd semester AY 2025 - 26 - Presentation by Dean SW.</p> <p>G-VAC courses for the Odd semester, Academic Year 2025-26 were presented by the Dean SW. The Dean SW informed the House that this year several new and diverse courses are being introduced under the GVAC (Gateway Value Added Courses) portfolio. These include innovative topics such as Finance for all, Robotics, AR/VR and others aimed at enhancing student learning beyond the core curriculum.</p> <p>It was heartening to see the strong and positive response from students towards GVAC courses like the Sports University Rai and the Counseling course run by Rishihood University among others.</p> <p>The House appreciated these enriching initiatives led by the Student Welfare team. Decision taken on Agenda (i)	<p>Any other point by permission of the chair</p> <p>Faculty Access to NDLI and INFLIBNET Resources</p> <p>The Director General, Gateway Education informed the House that IIT Kharagpur is leading the initiative of the National Digital Library of India (NDLI) and has designated state-specific Nodal Officers to promote awareness and usage of NDLI resources.</p> <p>It was recommended that all faculty members create individual NDLI accounts to access a wide range of free academic resources, including research papers, e-books and other scholarly content—thus minimizing the dependency on paid subscriptions.</p>

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	<p>Additionally attention was drawn to INFLIBNET a resource platform under the Ministry of Education which offers numerous free courses as part of the “One Nation One Subscription” initiative. However confirmation is required regarding the availability of this service to private institutions like ours.</p> <p>To facilitate seamless access it was decided that the Dean Academics in coordination with the librarian of Knowledge Resource Centre Gateway Higher Education will create an institutional login on the NDLI platform and INFLIBNET platforms. Once set up a detailed guide will be shared with all faculty members outlining how to utilize both NDLI and INFLIBNET for academic enrichment.</p> <p>Action: Dean A and Librarian Knowledge Resource Centre (Library) GHE</p> <p>Time: 10 Aug 25</p>
